General Rules of XEBEC

01. While entering the Institution pay due respect saying "Assalamu-Alaikum" to all faculty members and those who are senior in age.

- 02. Before joining XEBEC ensure the following
 - a. Shoes are cleaned and coloured.
 - b. Dress is clean, tidy and ironed properly.
 - c. Have a proper haircut.
 - d. Girl's hair is tied with white ribbon in two pony tails braided. Nails of your finger are properly trimmed.
 - e. Girls are not wearing ear top, any fancy watch and hair clips.
 - f. Only ear ring is allowed. Have bath in the morning and also brush your teeth properly.
 - G. You do not visit roadside shops.
- 03. Before joining class ensure the following:
 - Have prepared your lessons for the day.
 - Have completed the home assignments.
 - Don't move around in Verandah/Corridor during class hour.
 - Use the wash room earmarked for respective class.
- 04. While visiting wash room, ensure:
 - a. Have flushed it before leaving the toilet.
 - b. If it is not cleaned by flushing, make sure that enough water is poured and got it cleaned.
 - c. No sprinkle water in the wash room is used to avoid accident.
- 05. Senior students to be addressed as:
 - a. To male students (Bhaiya)
 - b. To girl students (Apu)
 - c. Male students must be very formal with their female class mates. Under no circumstances any one can afford to be funny with them. The relationship with them will be cordial but formal. They should be treated like your own sisters. Any complaint

- 04. Any student scolding anyone or using abusive language/offensive remarks shall receive warning letter. Repetition of same offence shall warrant one week suspension.
- 05. Any student who steals/cheats shall be given T.C.
- 06. Any student adopting unfairmeans in any exam (CT/Term Exam) shall be given T.C.
- 07. Any student disobeying teachers shall get a letter of warning. Repetition of same offence shall warrant suspension.
- 08. Any student failing to adhere to XEBEC instructions shall be warned.
- 09. Any student found developing illicit relationship with any other person, shall be given TC.
- 10. Any student writing offensive words on any wall shall be warned.
- 11. Any student who is proved to be involved in anti state activities possessing explosives, ammunitions, illegal papers etc shall be given TC.
- 12. Any student if caught possessing any expensive electrical devices (MP3 players/ Mobiles) shall be warned and the items will be seized.
- 13. Any student failing to report in time shall not be allowed to enter the school.
- 14. Any student seen with another student of opposite gender from Level (V-X) in any isolated place will be warned.
- 15. Any student leaving the school premises without permission from the authority will be issued with a warning letter. Repetition of same offence shall warrant suspension for two weeks.
- 16. Any student failing to pay tuition fee successively for three months shall have to take re-admission.

<u>Subject: English</u> <u>Guidelines for the Evaluation of Answer Scripts</u>

01. Oral Presentation: For oral presentation, student's pronunciation, confidence, eye contact, body language, posture, gesture, gait will be considered. For showing the satisfactory performance in every respect, full marks will be awarded. For missing of anyone from the above marks will be cut down accordingly.

02.Written of Letter:

- a) Letter: Size, shape, starting & finishing the line, writing instruction according to line will be counted. If everything is alright, 100% marks will be awarded. For any mistake or missing marks will be cut down accordingly.
- **b) Space between letters:** Instructed space must be followed. Otherwise marks will be cut down.
- c) Erasing or Overwriting: For erasing or overwriting marks will be cut down.
- **d)** Sharpening pencil: Write with thin line / nib of the pencil. If your line is thick marks will be cut down.
- e) Neatness of Sheet: Keep your answer script neat and clean. For any sort of untidiness marks will be cut down.

N.B.If problem arises beyond the scope of the above noted guide lines. In that case the decision taken by the authority shall be treated as decisive. 03. If a student misses any exam due to genuine sickness/ injury/accident/ admission to hospital/placed in bed rest, the marks of subjects shall be calculated basing on the mark obtained in any other term.

04. If any student misses exam without valid reason/ without approval from the authority, he/she shall not be awarded any mark for the subject missed.

05. Re-exam will never be conducted for the student who misses exams.

06. Any student failing in one subject shall not be promoted. He/She may be kept in the same class with the request of parent.

07. Students failing in more than one subject shall be given T.C.

08. Student failing in the same class for consecutive two years shall be given T.C.

09. Weak students must be taken care of separately by the subject teachers through extra classes after the normal academic periods.

10. Average marks for each subject shall be calculated with the addition of CT & term end exam.

Discipline Policy

- 01. Separate discipline committee shall be formed by Principal for a tenure of one year for junior and senior sections.
- 02. Basing on the recommendation of the discipline committee, Principal will take decision against defaulter.

03. Any student causing injury to another student which requires admission to hospital shall be given suspension for a period, not more than two weeks.

23. Recovery the guardian himself/herself would bring him/her to the school along with a medical certificate.

24. The guardians would see to it that their wards pay the tuition fees on the first day of the fixed date for fee collection every month. If any student adopt of unfair means and if he is found to be guilty of misconduct or if he denies the rules of the school or if he violates the discipline of the institution then the decision of the institution would be considered as the final one.

25. If any student is unsuccessful in the Final Term End Exam for promotion to higher class, no request will be entertained.

26. Those who would drop in and pickup their wards in and from XEBEC would do it on time. XEBEC shall not bear any responsibility.
